As a reminder to all members:

1) All invited guests who use the pool/Jacuzzi or court facilities must be signed in BEFORE they swim or play badminton at the guest registry. (The pool registry is located between the Jacuzzi and the Coke machine; the court registry is located on your left before you step down onto the courts.) If a guest plays badminton and uses the pool/Jacuzzi, they must be signed in on BOTH registries.

Remember, NO WET BATHING SUITS ON THE COURTS.

2) Children under the age of 18 must be supervised by an adult in the Club facility at all times. (This includes the courts, pool, etc)

3) All parties you may have at the Club must be approved by the House Chairman so they can be placed on the Club's Calendar.

The House Chairman alone cannot grant permission for parties of 20 or more, these events need to be presented to the Board for approval. The Board meets on the first Tuesday of every month so, please give me enough time (usually two months) to have the event approved.

All party requests should be sent to the House Chairman via email and should include the reason for the event, the number of people attending, activities that will take place and the age and number of children attending. A lifeguard is required when children are present at parties.

Private Parties require 1/3 invited guests be Club members.

4) If you notice any physical problems with the Club, please bring them to my attention with a call or preferably an email.

Thank you to all members who abide by the rules and policies of the Club. Remember we are all in this together.

The next Club Workday will be Saturday, September 8th, from 8am to 12pm; I hope to see you there!
